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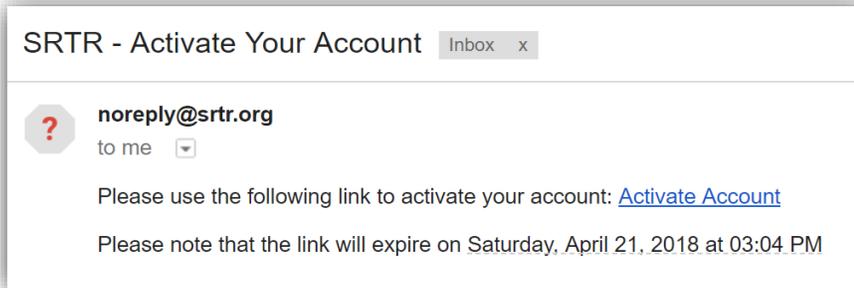

## Activate your Account- All Users

- 1) To enter your account for the first time, *use the link provided* in your welcome email from “noreply@srtr.org” and follow the instructions on the page. **\*\*Note:** The account will not activate unless you use the link provided in the welcome email.



- Enter your email address as your username.
- Copy and paste your temporary password into the password box.

**Government Regulations**

  - 3) Copy and paste your temporary password into the “Old Password” box, then create a new password.
    - New passwords must contain at least 8 digits.
    - It is strongly suggested that new passwords:
      - Include both uppercase and lowercase letters.
      - Include at least one special character (i.e., \$, #, \*).
  - 4) You will be notified that your password has been changed successfully. An email will automatically be sent to your email address confirming the new password.

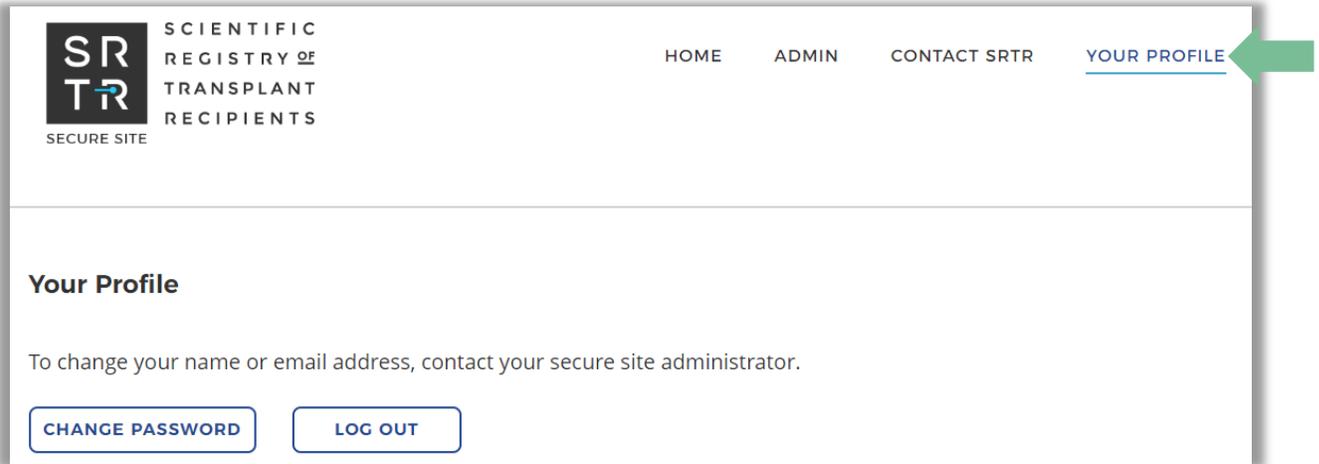
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### View your Administrator Profile- Admins Only

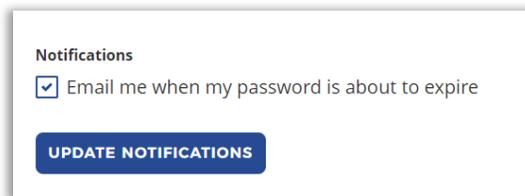
- 1) Once your password is updated and your account is activated, you can view the administrator page by clicking on the “Admin” option in the navigation bar at the top of the page.



- 2) You can access your profile by clicking the “Your Profile” link in the navigation bar.



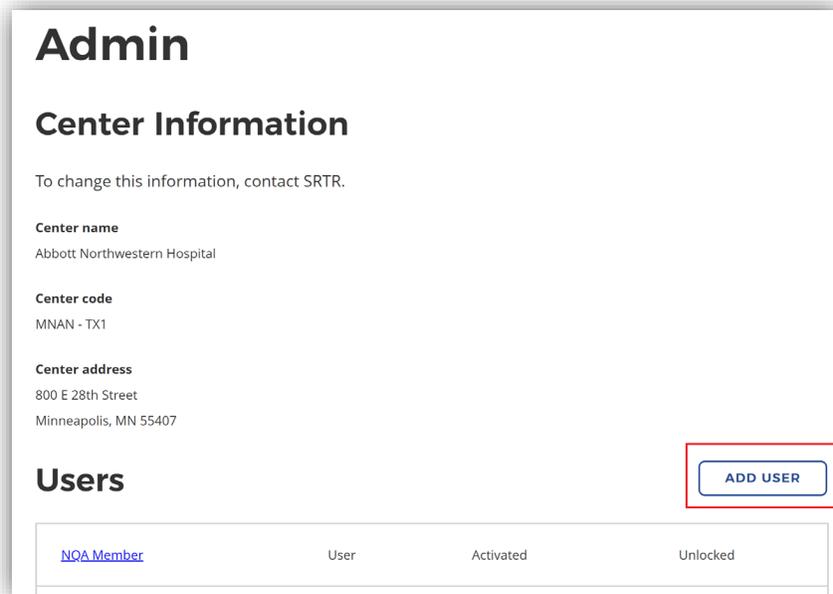
- 3) The “Your Profile” page will appear with your information. You can change the information on this page as necessary. **\*\*Note:** There is an option at the bottom of the page to remind you when your password will expire. Make sure this box is checked.

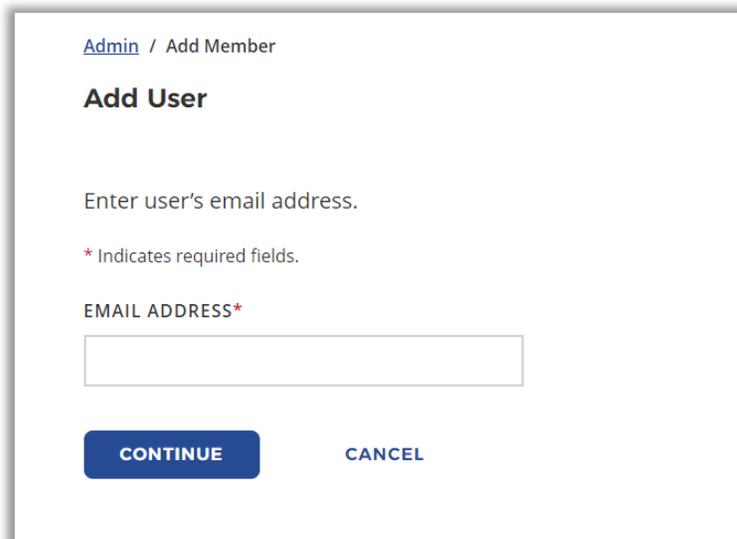

- 5) Check the boxes under Organ Program subscriptions to allow the user access to specific organ programs. You may select as many boxes as appropriate. You must check at least one box. **\*\*Note:** For any box not checked, the corresponding tab for that organ will not appear in the navigation tabs for the new user.
- 6) **For OPO Administrators**, you must make sure *all* organs are checked.
- 7) When the new user's information is complete, click the "Add User" button on the bottom, left to enter the information into the SRTR system. **\*\*Note:** Once you click "Add User," you will not be able to edit the user's email address.
- You will be able to change the permissions for various organ programs at a later time.
  - You cannot add an administrator. To add a person as an administrator, you must contact [srtr@srtr.org](mailto:srtr@srtr.org) and give them the name and email address of the person you wish to add as an admin.
  - A confirmation message will pop up when the user has been added informing you they have been sent an activation message.

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**View and Edit Users- Admins Only**

- 1) To view your center’s users, return to the administrator homepage. You will see a table listing all the users at your program and their status.
- 2) To edit a user’s permissions, click the person’s name, which is a link to their account page.

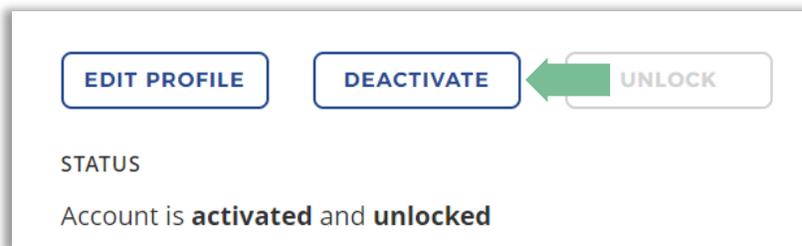

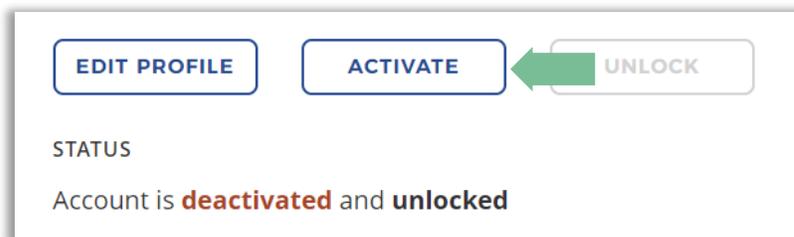
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## Deactivate, Reactivate or Unlock a User- Admins Only

- 1) Follow the instructions in items 1 and 2 of “View and Edit Users for Your Center” section above. Then click the “Deactivate” button. Save this change by clicking “Update.” Access will be removed for this user.



- The system will give you a warning message asking if you really want to deactivate this user.
  - Deactivated users will remain in your user list, but they will no longer be able to log in and see your organization’s information.
- 2) Likewise, if you need to re-activate someone, they will have a button that says “Activate” instead of “Deactivate”. Simply click that button to reactivate them.



- 3) If their account is locked, the “Unlock” button will be blue.
  - If the users account is “Locked” and you have difficulty unlocking it, please contact [srtr@srtr.org](mailto:srtr@srtr.org).
- 4) If you want to *delete* a deactivated user, please contact [srtr@srtr.org](mailto:srtr@srtr.org).

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
